



EU AID TO UKRAINE FOR COVID-19

RECOVERY AND VACCINATION

EU supplies almost every third vaccine dose to Ukraine



As of January 14, almost 27,3% of total number of vaccine doses obtained by Ukraine came from the EU within the COVAX program

3.7 million dozes of vaccines Ukraine has received from the FU



The number of Ukrainians with Digital COVID-19 **Certificate** is increasing

Over

10 millions

of Ukrainians vaccinated with two doses received the digital COVID-19 certificates (as of January 14)



of Ukrainian citizens are fully vaccinated due by the direct support of the EU Action in support for COVID-19 vaccine deployment organized in cooperation with WHO (ca 55 2% of all fully vaccinated Ukrainians)

17 536 persons of the overall number of Ukrainian healthcare workers involved in COVID-19 vaccine delivery were trained within 650 2-days offline trainings organized by the EU

SME Support

SME development remains a priority of EU external assistance

The main COVID-19 response activities included:

Establishment of 7 COVID-19 "Business - Clinics"

for SMEs which served over 8000 clients from all around Ukraine (out of them 66% of participants were women; 50% of participants micro enterprises with up to 10 employees)





COVID-19 **SME Survevs**

1,496 respondents were involved (owners and managers of enterprises, including micro, small, medium and large businesses)

COVID-19 Municipal Response

161 events delivered to 1302 participants, of which 50.3% were women and **73.1%** were business representatives
