ECONOMIC AND FINANCIAL SUPPORT

- €50 billion in financial and budget support, and humanitarian assistance so far
- 136 million tonnes of goods exported and more than 52 million tonnes of goods imported, thanks to the Solidarity Lanes
- Trade facilitations and association to key EU programmes like Connecting Europe Facility, the Single Market programme and Horizon 2020
- Up to **€50 billion** to provide predictable and flexible support to Ukraine for the period 2024-2027, thanks to the Ukraine Facility



HOLDING RUSSIA ACCOUNTABLE

- 13 sanctions packages
- 2,000 individuals and entities sanctioned
- Over €28 billion of their private assets are frozen in the EU
- About **€210 billion** of Russian Central Bank assets are immobilised in the EU

TEMPORARY PROTECTION

- More than 4 million people fleeing the war received temporary protection in the EU
- Up to €17 billion made available to Member States to cater for the needs of people fleeing the war

MILITARY ASSISTANCE

- €32 billion under the European Peace Facility and by Member States individually
- Over 50 000 military trained
 - HUMANITARIAN ASSISTANCE
- The biggest EU Civil Protection Mechanism operation ever
- 860 million in humanitarian assistance
- Over 148 000 tonnes of in-kind assistance with an estimated value of over €814 million
- More than **7 700** power generators
