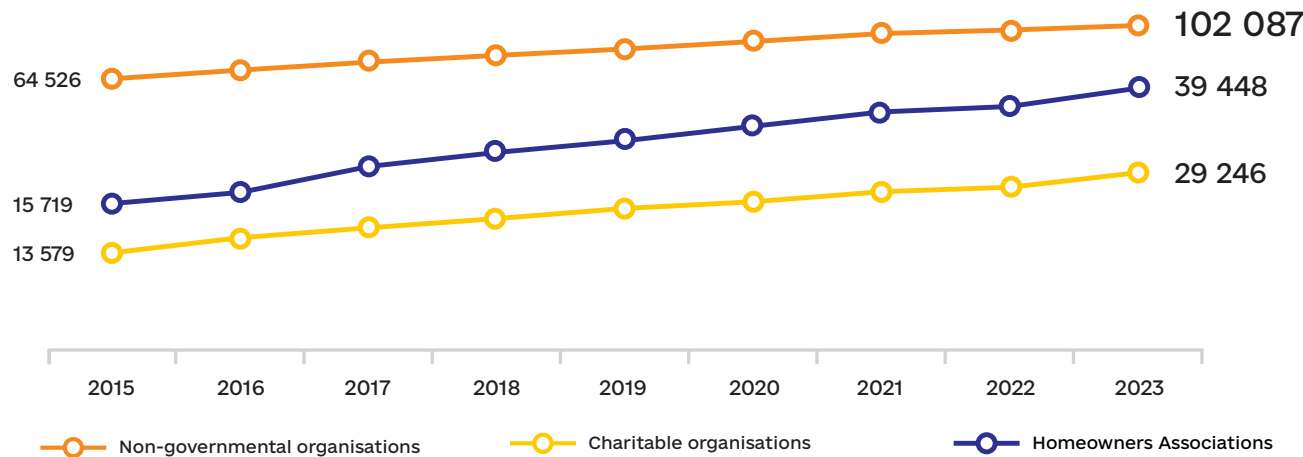

EU grant assistance for Ukrainian civil society organisations

Over **€101 million** allocated for the ongoing EU grant support

56 large grants in operation as of June 2024

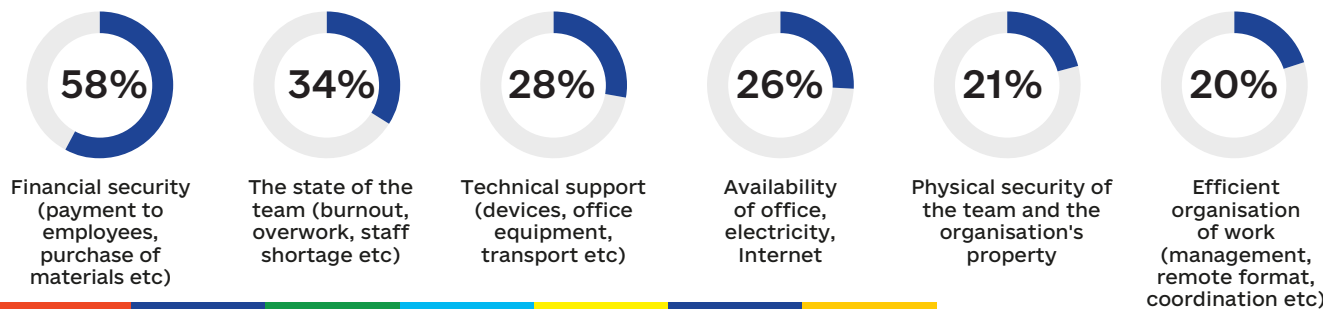
€299K of the minimum grant amount and **€10m** of the maximum grant amount

1 877 sub-grant projects are being implemented

346 sub-grant projects implemented through regional grant programmes

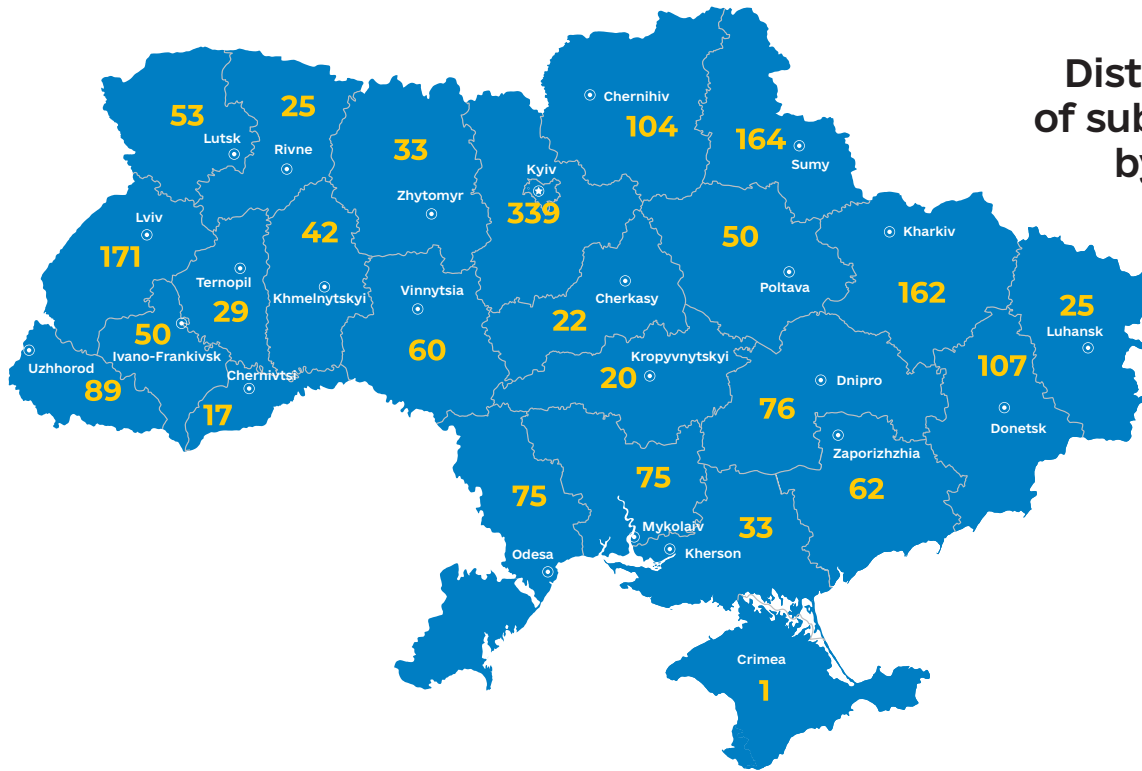
€500 of the minimum sub-grant amount and **€639K** of the maximum sub-grant amount

*Data based on the results of the ISAR Edhannia survey; the percentage is based on the number of organisations that voiced the above problems during the survey.

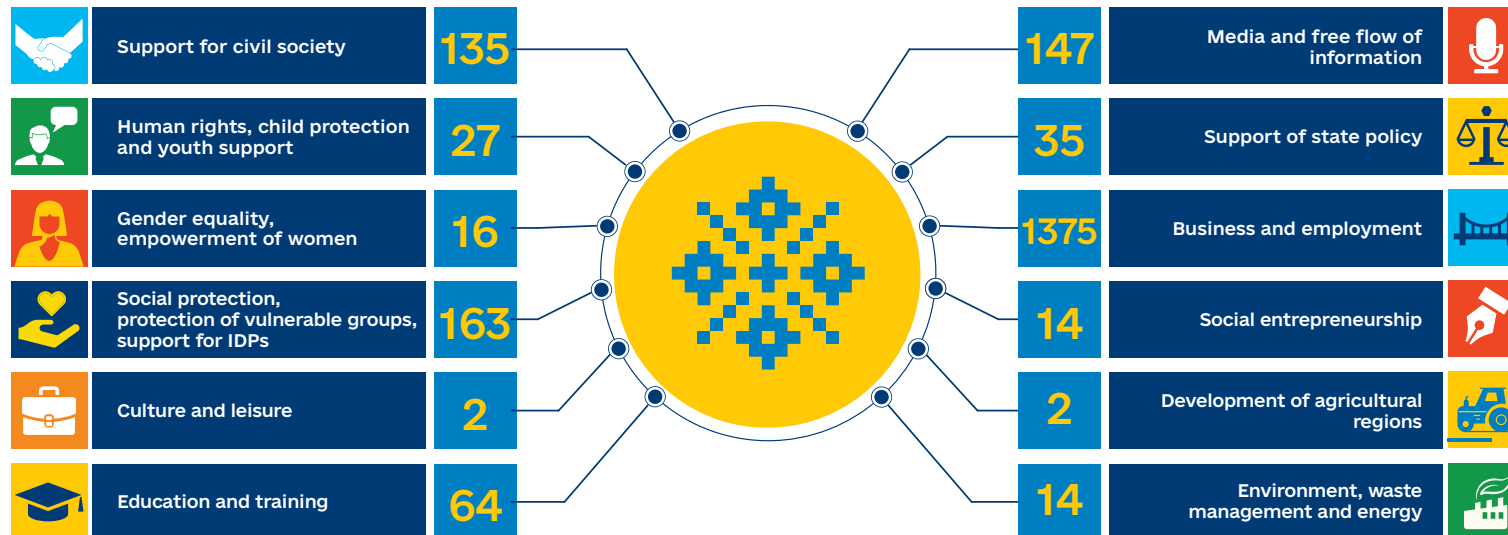
Distribution of sub-grants by region
