

UPSKILLING

EU has improved capacity of Ukrainian VET to raise skills of Ukrainians meeting labour market requirements.

EU has contributed to the development of skills relevant for the post-war recovery and support short and medium-term trainings for different groups of learners, including internally displaced persons (IDPs) and former combatants

Overall, **36 VET** institutions were supported, including equipping with:

- 400 electric generators
- **18** buses
- 25 computer cabinets
- 179.534 textbooks
- 5 VET schools provided with modern agriculture and road construction equipment
- 8 VET schools are currently under modernisation
- 7 VET Centres of excellence will be established in Ukraine

SUPPORT FOR UNIVERSITIES UNDER ERASMUS+ PROGRAMME

EU has secured higher education development:

- 4 universities relocated
- infrastructure development, improvement of curricula and University and students' governance
- 9172 international mobilities for Universities staff, students and young people (13-30 years old)
- 13 Erasmus Mundus Joint Master Programmes projects
- **138** Master Degree students scholarships provided;
- 256 Jean Monnet (European Studies) projects (grants up to EUR 100,000 per project)
- Digital University in Ukraine established
- 40 HEIs joined over 25 European Universities Alliances

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SAFE EDUCATION

EU ensured continuous education for Ukrainian schoolchildren through support of

- Online school 'SchoolToGo'
- All-Ukrainian Schools Online Platform
- Facilities for tutors and children (laptops, etc.)

OPPORTUNITIES FOR YOUTH

EU granted opportunities for young people:

- involvement in local decision making
- civic initiatives
- cultural and social cohesion events, dialogue forums
- youth-led volunteering activities
- art-therapy classes and anti-stress techniques
- support for young veterans and internally displaced persons in Ukraine
- fostering veteran entrepreneurship
- EU Networks (EU Information Centres, EU Study Days, Euroclubs, Euroquiz, European Young Ambassadors)

ACCESS TO EDUCATION

To improve education facilities, EU has supported renewal of an offline educational process:

- **420+** schools and kindergartens renewed or under construction
- 363 buses from the EU and EU Member States
- Digital Learning Centres established to eliminate educational gaps
- Over 1,5 mln textbooks for schoolchildren
- 500 interactive exercises and 320 classes provided with new curriculum of Informatics and all educational materials
- **1480** education institutions received access to European School Education Platform
