ECONOMIC AND FINANCIAL SUPPORT

- almost €75.8 billion in financial and budget support, and humanitarian assistance so far
- 176 million tonnes of goods exported and around 72 million tonnes of goods imported, thanks to the Solidarity Lanes
- Trade facilitations and association to key EU programmes like Connecting Europe Facility, the Single Market programme and Horizon 2020
- Up to €50 billion to provide predictable and flexible support to Ukraine for the period 2024-2027, thanks to the Ukraine Facility
- Up to €18.1 billion of Macro-Financial Assistance in 2025



HOLDING RUSSIA ACCOUNTABLE

- 16 sanctions packages
- Over 2 300 individuals and entities sanctioned
- Over **€28 billion** of their private assets are frozen in the EU
- Over **€210 billion** of Russian Central Bank assets are immobilised in the EU



TEMPORARY PROTECTION

- More than 4 million people fleeing the war received temporary protection in the EU
- Up to €17 billion made available to Member States to cater for the needs of people fleeing the war



MILITARY ASSISTANCE

- €49.6 billion under the European Peace Facility and by Member States individually
- 73 000 military trained
- €1.5 billion generated from immobilised Russian assets made available in support of Ukraine



HUMANITARIAN ASSISTANCE

- The biggest EU Civil Protection Mechanism operation ever
- Almost 1.1 billion in humanitarian assistance
- Over 154 000 tonnes of in-kind assistance
- More than 8 900 power generators
