ECONOMIC AND FINANCIAL SUPPORT

- almost **€75.8 billion** in financial and budget support, and humanitarian assistance so far
- **176 million tonnes** of goods exported and around **72 million tonnes** of goods imported, thanks to the Solidarity Lanes
- Trade facilitations and association to key EU programmes like Connecting Europe Facility, the Single Market programme and Horizon 2020
- Up to **€50 billion** to provide predictable and flexible support to Ukraine for the period 2024-2027, thanks to the Ukraine Facility
- Up to **€18.1 billion** of Macro-Financial Assistance in 2025



HOLDING RUSSIA ACCOUNTABLE

- **16** sanctions packages
- Over **2 300 individuals** and entities sanctioned
- Over **€28 billion** of their private assets are frozen in the EU
- Over **€210 billion** of Russian Central Bank assets are immobilised in the EU



TEMPORARY PROTECTION

- More than **4 million** people fleeing the war received temporary protection in the EU
- Up to **€17 billion** made available to Member States to cater for the needs of people fleeing the war



MILITARY ASSISTANCE

- **€49.6 billion** under the European Peace Facility and by Member States individually
- **73 000** military trained
- **€1.5 billion** generated from immobilised Russian assets made available in support of Ukraine



HUMANITARIAN ASSISTANCE

- The biggest EU Civil Protection Mechanism operation ever
- Almost **1.1 billion** in humanitarian assistance
- Over **154 000 tonnes** of in-kind assistance
- More than **8 900** power generators
