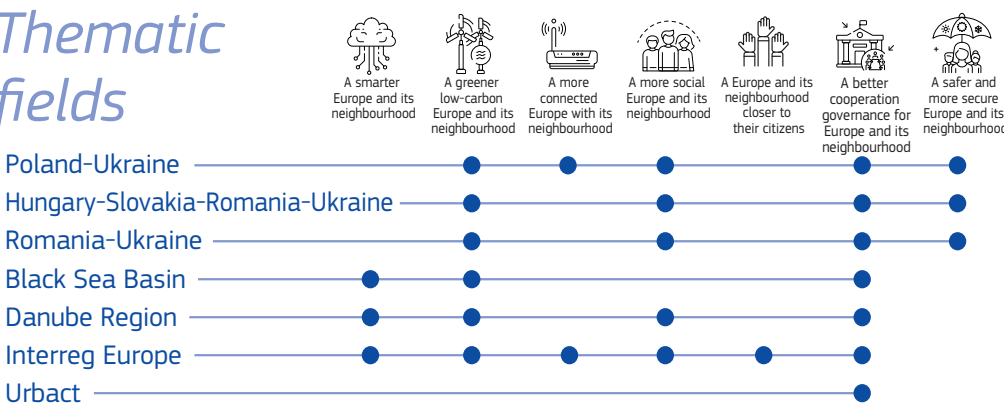
A strong and lasting partnership

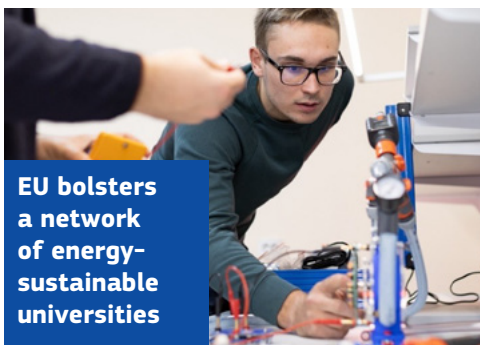
